Set within the heart of the South Cheshire countryside, in a village that is listed in the Domesday Book, the stunningly beautiful Wrenbury Hall is steeped in history.

It is believed to have been a shelter for the Roundheads in 1643, just before the Battle of Nantwich during the English Civil War. Parts of the building still date from the 17th Century although the building was refaced, in 1916-1919, in an Elizabethan style using sandstone.

The Hall had many uses in the 20th century, and was latterly used as a training centre for ambulance personnel until bought by the present owners in 1982 and restored to its original condition.

The Hall is now used principally as a venue for weddings, banquets, and corporate events. However, for one night only, November 20th, 2009, Desmond Mullock and family offer you a rare opportunity to enjoy an exquisite three course meal, coupled with a full evenings musical entertainment, provided by the cream of Cheshire's young musicians, within the sumptuous surroundings of this stunning building. The event is perfect for a special pre-Christmas evening with a partner or with friends, and would make an ideal corporate hospitality evening to bring along valued customers and clients.

THE SCYM EXPERIENCE

SCYM was formed in 2006 by David F Ketley with the principal aim of providing opportunities for young performers to develop their musical skills and gain the essential experience of performing in front of an audience, as well as providing financial help with tuition fees and instrument purchase.

The inaugural concert was given at Ruskin College in Crewe and involved performers of many different instruments and of all levels of ability. Ages ranged from 6 to 16 and fourteen local schools were represented that evening. The event was such a success that it was decided to add different venues and to include musicians up to the age of 24, in so doing encouraging those who were on the verge of a professional career in music. Thus our series of concerts in the long gallery at Crewe Hall began where we have the very best young musicians from the Cheshire/Staffordshire area. These concerts have now become a regular feature of our programme, and we continue to stage them there three times annually, in most cases to sell-out audiences.

We are delighted to report that two of our members have recently started their professional careers as music teachers and performers, and indeed one has already played at the Royal Albert Hall in the 2008 Promenade Concerts season.

In order to encourage youngsters, up to the age of 18, to write their own music, a "Young Composer of the Year" competition was started at the end of 2006. This has since become an annual event.

Since that time SCYM has forged links with the BBC Philharmonic Orchestra, and they have supported our competition for the last two years, with the finalists being invited to visit the BBC studios to attend a live radio broadcast. The BBC have pledged to continue supporting SCYM, and this year, have again sent us complimentary tickets to enable us to give youngsters the amazing experience of hearing one of the finest orchestras in Europe at The Bridgewater Hall in Manchester.

Performing on this special night will be some of the finest young musicians in the North of England who will be playing a wide variety of instruments and music, both as soloists and in small ensembles.
